

Call for papers - ITMN special issue

Dos Algarves: A Multidisciplinary e-Journal (DAMeJ) is planning an ITMN special issue, with a view to publication in May 2020, which will showcase some of the best recent work resulting from masters' dissertations submitted to ITMN partner universities.

We invite you to submit abstracts for one of the following types of paper: full research article; critical literature review; short communication. Further details are given below. Please note that preference will be given to full research papers.

Full research article (5000-7000 words) which shows the results of masters level research, that is, a paper written after completion of the research project. The paper should therefore contain all the typical elements of a research paper, including research objectives, literature review, methodology, results/findings and discussion, conclusions. NB: This type of paper should be <u>co-authored with a supervisor</u>. Abstracts should be 300 - 500 words.

Critical literature review (2500-3000 words) of a theoretical, conceptual or methodological nature, which advances scholarship by providing original, insightful and useful perspectives on some aspect(s) of tourism, management and/or hospitality. This type of submission may or may not be co-authored by a supervisor. Abstracts should be 150-200 words.

Short communication/ **Research report** (up to 2500 words), which should present and discuss preliminary data and findings of a current research project and should include a short discussion and emerging conclusions. This type of submission may or may not be co-authored by a supervisor. Abstracts should be 150-200 words.

Languages of publication: DAMeJ publishes work in English, Portuguese or Spanish

Deadline for submission of abstract: March 31st 2019

Notification of acceptance of abstracts: April 30th 2019

Deadline for submission of full manuscript (if abstract is accepted): September 30th 2019*
