How to reach the venue

The University can be reached by **train** (Station **Milano Greco-Pirelli**), **metro** (**M5 – lilac line**, stop “Bicocca”) or by **bus** (line **87** – stop “Piazza Ateneo Nuovo”) and **tram** (line **7** - stop “Ateneo Nuovo”).

Bike Sharing service **BikeMi** is available and **Mobike** and **OFO** floating systems.

A **taxi** service is also available (tel. 02 5353).



From Milano Linate

take the **bus number 73** direction **S. Babila M1**. Get off at the final stop and take metro line **M1**(red line) direction “**Sesto 1 Maggio FS**”. Get off at “**Precotto**”, walk 2 minutes to reach **tram number 7** stop, direction “Piazzale Lagosta” to stop “Ateneo Nuovo”.



From Milano Malpensa

take the train **Malpensa Express** to **Milano Porta Garibaldi Station** (direction **Milano Centrale**). At Milano Porta Garibaldi station take a train direction Chiasso or Como to reach “Milano Greco Pirelli” Station. From the Station to the Conference Venue is about 5 minutes walking.

Otherwise take metro **M5** (lilac line) to “Bicocca” stop, then walk for 10 minutes to reach the venue.



From Central Station

Take bus 87 (direction “Villa S.Giovanni”) from “Piazza Quattro Novembre” (right exit from the Station) for 13 stops.
